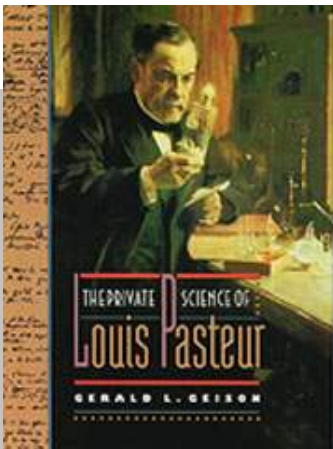


*“Greatest biologist of all time”*
